THE RFA ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT 2009

1. The 47th Annual RFA Golf Tournament will be held at Waterlooville Golf Club, at Cowplain near Portsmouth on **Thursday 02nd July**. This year we have Rolls Royce as the main sponsor with ever generous support from Scottish & Newcastle and prizes have been donated by several companies. With their support, the total cost for the day will be £40.00; green fees will again be partly subsidised; lunch and prizes provided and wine for dinner will be inclusive in the price. We will intend to have a raffle and proceeds will go towards the proposed RFA Memorial through our registered charity the RFA Association.
2. The event is open to all RFA serving and retired Officers, Petty Officers, Ratings and Cadets. Guests are welcome, however space is limited and the recommendation is a maximum of **2 guests** on the day.
3. The permissible handicap for the competition is up to 24 for men and 30 for ladies; current handicap certificates for new participants will be required. Each Player's must have his scorecard independently recorded, verified on completion and then signed by the player and countersigned by the partner.
